

Appointed Assessor Law of the Town of Berkshire

Town of Berkshire Local Law No. 1 of the year 1987

◆SECTION I - PURPOSE

The purpose of this Local Law is to provide that there shall be one Assessor for the Town of Berkshire to be appointed as provided in Section three hundred ten of the Real Property Tax of the State of New York.

◆SECTION II - OFFICE OF ASSESSOR

From and after January 1, 1988 there shall be one Assessor in the Town of Berkshire who shall be appointed by the Town Board for a term of six (6) years. Any previous appointee terms of office will terminate on January 1, 1988.

◆SECTION III - REFERENDUM

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 328 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the Town Board has determined, in its discretion, that this Local Law shall be subject to a permissive referendum.

◆SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect upon receiving a majority vote in the affirmative of the qualified electors thereon, if submitted for referendum, and after filing in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
